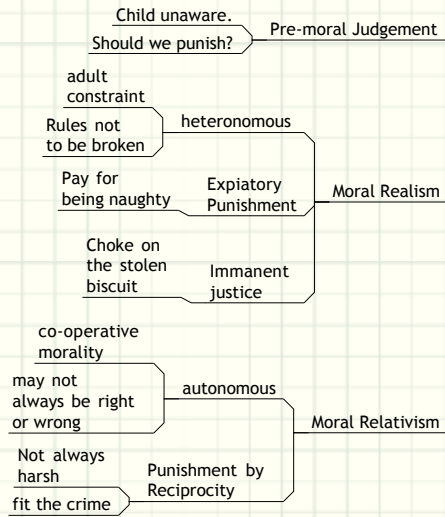
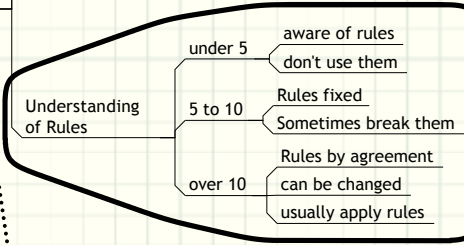

Aims



Judgements of wrongdoing and punishment

stupid lie

Tree can play the piano
I can play the piano not so stupid

Understanding of telling lies

⊕

Aim: Investigate moral judgement in Children

Method: moral dilemma

- intentionally naughty?
- How much damage caused?

Results

- Under 10
 - judgement based on DAMAGE caused
 - No account of intentions
 - Harsher punishments
- Over 10
 - Judgement based on intentions
 - Limited punishment related to wrongdoing

Conclusion

- Over 10, can think for self
- can take more than one factor into account

Evaluation

- High cognitive effort required. Can young children cope with this?
- Can young kids cope with two stories?
- Doesn't consider all combinations of intention and damage

Nelson (1980)

considers all 4 possibilities
Page 66 Pennington
Showed that Piaget UNDERESTIMATED capabilities of young children (Surprise!!!)
